



### Here's what happens...

Jesus begins his most famous sermon, the Sermon on the Mount, with the Beatitudes. Jesus lists kinds of people who seem lowly or down and out and names the reward they are promised. Jesus flips everything upside down by demonstrating that those who seem to be struggling are actually blessed.

### Bible Point:

God blesses those who struggle.

*"In the same way, let your good deeds shine out for all to see, so that everyone will praise your heavenly Father" (Matthew 5:16).*

- Think of someone your family knows who's struggling. It could be someone who's sick, grieving, out of work, or having another kind of hard time.
